Pepperoni Pizza

You can make a pepperoni pizza in our pizza oven and enjoy it in your room or anywhere inside or outside the B&B. The pizzas are \$11.00 including tax for the two of you. In case no one is available, **you are welcome to help yourself** to a pizza in the kitchen freezer. The pizza oven and microwave are inside the cupboard in the Dining Room. Pizza cutter, silverware, napkins, etc. are in the drawers below the counter.

Of course, you are welcome to help yourself to our complimentary wine, water and soft drinks.

Do-It-Yourself Grilling. For grilling, you are welcome to bring your food, or purchase it at a local store. We have a small gas grill for your use along with a basket containing plates, silverware, napkins, glasses, salt and pepper and a candle for ambience.

Light Meals in Danbury



The **Fish Bowl** (so named because this area is known as Wisconsin's Fish Bowl) **Sports Bar** is our first choice for a light meal nearby. Located on Wisconsin Highway 35, two miles north of the stop sign in Danbury, this is the place where the locals go.

The Fish Bowl has a full menu every day except Tuesdays when they feature prime rib sandwiches, and Thursdays, when they feature half pound burgers for \$4.99.

The Deli at St. Croix Casino, Danbury offers quick-serve deli items. In addition, they occasionally feature "Sliders" in the bar area which are small sandwiches of tender roast beef on a bun that some people rave about. Smoking is permitted in the Deli and the Bar but not the Restaurant or Buffet. (See remarks below about the casino's restaurant and buffet.)

Log Cabin Store & Restaurant is open seven days a week and features quick-serve fried chicken, hamburgers, Subway-type sandwiches and ice cream.

Wild Waters, with its log siding front, is located on Danbury's Main Street. Their food is good, especially their stuffed burgers. Their service has been inconsistent and their prices are more city-like.

Light Meals in Siren

In Siren we recommend either **Adventures** (see next page) or the **Pour House**. Both are on the main highway going through town. Also, **Little Mexico**, located two miles south of Siren, has plain atmosphere but very good Mexican food. They are open Friday, Saturday and Sunday only.

Getting to Danbury, Webster and Siren is easy. From Woodland Trails' driveway, go right back to Highway 48. At the stop sign turn left and cross the bridge into Wisconsin. At the only stop sign in Danbury turn right on to Wisconsin Highway 35 and follow it for 9 miles to Webster and further on for 6 miles to Siren.

Our Recommendations for a Special Dinner

Grand Casino, Hinckley

23 miles from Woodland Trails

The best restaurant in our area is The Winds Steakhouse located inside Grand Casino Hinckley. The entrance is near the Winds sign, to the left of the casino main entrance. Using this entrance you can avoid the cigarette smoke in the casino. There is no smoking in the casino restaurants.



The food, the service and the atmosphere at The Winds are all excellent. Their full menu offers choices of steaks, seafood and chicken. Dinner prices generally range from \$20 to \$30. The Winds opens at 5pm Wednesday through Sunday.

A caution is that they do not take reservations. One option is to be at their door when they open at 5:00 (on busy Friday and Saturday nights you might need to be there 20 to 30 minutes before 5:00.) A second option is to get put on their waiting list by calling as you leave here – 320-384-7771.

Two more choices are located in Siren, Wisconsin, 20 miles from Woodland Trails.

Adventures Restaurant

Located on Hwy 35 in Siren, Adventures is open daily and is a good second choice, particularly for those who do not want to go to a casino.

Adventures' full menu includes burgers, sandwiches and dinner items such as steak, chicken, walleye and pasta. A special recommendation is the Steak and Caesar Salad. Beverages include soft drinks, cocktails, wine and many choices of beer.



Tesora Restaurant

Tesora, also located in Siren at the only stop light in town, offers chef-prepared steaks, chicken, fish and pasta plus pizza made in their wood-fired oven. You are likely to be greeted by owner, Jake Mengelson. This newly redecorated restaurant includes linen tablecloths and napkins.

We recommend calling Tesora for a reservation at 715-349-7878. Be sure to mention you are a guest at Woodland Trails!

St. Croix Casino, Danbury

Just 4 miles from Woodland Trails

The St. Croix Casino, Danbury, has The East Winds Restaurant, which is open seven days a week and features hamburgers to chicken, fish, steaks and chops. **The South Winds Buffet** is also open daily but seems to have the atmosphere of a high school cafeteria. The **North Winds Deli** offers hot and cold sandwiches, soups, salads and dessert items.



The **West Winds Lounge** offers complimentary entertainment every weekend. Smoking is permitted in the Deli and the Bar but not the Restaurant or Buffet.

Day Trip with a Dining Experience

Enjoy a Day Trip to Duluth, which is a little over an hour away on Wisconsin Highway 35, topped off with an outstanding dinner at:

Bellisio's Italian Restaurant. Located in the **Waterfront Area of Duluth**, Bellisio's is fashioned after the quaint hillside wine markets and local restaurants found in small Italian villages.
