## Do It Yourself Pizza at Woodland Trails

Particularly good on arrival evening .... or for a shack anytime.



Pepperoni Pizza

You can make a pepperoni pizza in our pizza oven and enjoy it in your room or anywhere inside or outside the B&B. The pizzas are \$11.00 including tax for the two of you. In case no one is available, you are welcome to help yourself to a pizza in the kitchen freezer. The pizza oven and microwave are inside the cupboard in the Dining Room. Pizza cutter. silverware, napkins, etc. are in the drawers below the counter.

Of course, you are welcome to help yourself to our complimentary wine, water and soft drinks.

**Do-It-Yourself Grilling.** For grilling, you are welcome to bring your food, or purchase it at a local store. We have a small gas grill for your use along with a basket containing plates, silverware, napkins, glasses, salt and pepper and a candle for ambience.



# Choices in Danbury

The **Fish Bowl** (so named because this area is known as Wisconsin's Fish Bowl) Sports Bar is our first choice for a light meal nearby. Located on Wisconsin Highway 35, two miles north of the stop sign in Danbury, this is the place where the locals go.

The Fish Bowl has a full menu every day except Tuesdays, when they feature prime rib sandwiches, and Thursdays, when they feature half pound burgers for \$4.99.

The St. Croix Casino, Danbury, has The East Winds Restaurant, which is open seven days a week and features hamburgers to chicken, fish, steaks and chops. The South Winds Buffet is also open daily but seems to have the atmosphere of a high school cafeteria. The North Winds Deli offers quickserve hot and cold sandwiches, soups, salads and dessert items.

Log Cabin Store & Restaurant is open seven days a week and features quick-serve fried chicken. hamburgers, Subway-type sandwiches and ice cream.

On Friday evening (the only evening they are open for dinner), enjoy a genuine Mexican diner at Amelia's Homestead Cafe. Located on Main Street, Amelia and Jose' welcome you.

Wild Waters, with its log siding front, is located on Danbury's Main Street. Their food is good, especially their stuffed burgers, but service has been inconsistent and their prices are more city-like.

### Light Meals in Siren

In Siren we recommend either Adventures (see next page) or the Pour House. Both are on the main highway going through town. Also, Little Mexico, located two miles south of Siren, has plain atmosphere but very good Mexican food. They are open Friday, Saturday and Sunday only.

Getting to Danbury, Webster and Siren is easy. From Woodland Trails' driveway, go right back to Highway 48. At the stop sign turn left and cross the bridge into Wisconsin. At the only stop sign in Danbury turn right on to Wisconsin Highway 35 and follow it for 9 miles to Webster and further on for 6 miles to Siren.

# **Our Recommendations for a Special Dinner**

#### Grand Casino, Hinckley

23 miles from Woodland Trails The best restaurant in our area is The Winds Steakhouse

**located inside Grand Casino Hinckley.** The entrance is near the Winds sign, to the left of the casino main entrance. Using this entrance you can avoid the cigarette smoke in the casino. There is no smoking in the casino restaurants.

The food, the service and the atmosphere at The Winds are all excellent. Their full menu offers choices of steaks, seafood and chicken. Dinner prices generally range from \$20 to \$30. The Winds opens at 5pm Wednesday through Sunday.



A caution is that they do not take reservations. One option is to be at their door when they open at 5:00 (on busy Friday and Saturday nights you might need to be there 20 to30 minutes before 5:00.) If you want to get there later, they will put you on their waiting list if you call as you leave here – 320-384-7771.

## Violet on Cedar

Comfort food with Swedish influences. Located 13 miles from Woodland Trails at 7438 Cedar St. W., Webster WI – 715-566-3813 www.VioletOnCedar.com

Our area's newest restaurant is also the most unique. They serve a wide variety of wine. Food is limited to small plates, soups and dessert, all perfect for a light meal.

Violet on Cedar, open from 4-8 pm Thursday, Friday and Saturday, is located in a home that was completely remodeled for the restaurant. The setting is very clean and relaxing. See a sample of their menu on our Entryway Desk.



## **Adventures Restaurant**

Located on WI Hwy 35 in Siren, Wisconsin, 20 miles from Woodland Trails.

Adventures is open daily and is a good second choice, particularly for those who do not want to go to a casino. Their full menu includes burgers, sandwiches and dinner items such as steak, chicken, walleye and pasta. A special recommendation is the Steak and Caesar Salad.

After a little shopping in Hayward, one hour east on WI Hwy 77, enjoy **ITALIA! Ristorante Italiano** which is located 15 minutes outside of Hayward at 14311 County Rd K. Their menu presents a wide range of Italian dishes including Bistecca Toscana, Tuscan style USDA Prime NY Strip, to Spaghetti Bolognese (outstanding!), to Gameretti alla Grigla, grilled colossal shrimp (huge!) on spaghetti in garlic, pepper and olive oil sauce.

They also offer eight choices of thin-crust pizzas, topped with homemade sauce and fresh mozzarella chest, and paninis served with homemade potato chips or a cup of their zuppa di giorno. Open at 4:00 pm Tuesday through Saturday. 715-699-1238
